Subject: Georgia State Family of the Year Program

The following rules and regulations govern the Georgia State Family of the Year program.

1. Eligibility. Eligibility for the Georgia State Family of the Year program are the same as for the Order's Family of the Year program as stated in the Family of the Month forms booklet distributed to all councils at the beginning of the fraternal year.
2. Method of Nomination. Local councils need only complete the Family of the Year form in the forms booklet. Additional paper is permissible, as necessary. Photographs, newspaper articles, letters of commendation, or other special exhibits may be included. Mail nominations to:

3. Format. Your council's entry must be completed on the Family of the Year Form available in the 2016-2017 Council Family of the Month booklet, or on-line at <http://www.kofc.org/un/eb/en/officers/forms/council.html>. Follow the instructions provided on that form.
4. Judging. The State Deputy will serve as the selection committee, calling on others as needed to review the candidates and confer on the selection in total secrecy.
5. The award will be presented at the Georgia State Council Annual Meeting Banquet. The selected family need not be present at the banquet.
6. The family selected as the Georgia State Council Family of the Year will be submitted to the Supreme Council for consideration as the International Knights of Columbus Family of the Year.
7. Deadline for Submission. All submissions must be received by April 14, 2017. Nominations not meeting these criteria will be rejected.
